



A PSALM OF THANKSGIVING

Psalm 100

Vs. 1

- “Shout joyfully to the Lord”
- “All the earth”
 - Universal – not just one nation or people

Vs. 2

- “Serve the Lord with gladness...”
 - *Serve the LORD with fear and celebrate his rule with trembling. (Ps. 2:11 NIV)*
 - “Fear becomes the exalted Lord, and the holy gravity of His requirements; joy becomes the gracious Lord, and His blessed service.” (K&D)

Vs. 3

- The reason for the joy.
- “Know”
- “The Lord is God”
 - King – powerful – His way and His will are established forever.
 - Judge – Hears all, sees all, knows all.
 - Righteous – nothing to do with crooked judges – Righteousness will flourish.

Vs. 3

- “It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves”
 - He has made me happy
 - No wrong in Him
 - Those He corrects are happy

Vs. 3

- “We are His people and the sheep of His pasture”
 - Psalm 95
 - *Worship the LORD in the splendor of holiness; tremble before him, all the earth! (Ps. 96:9 ESV)*

Vs 4

- “Enter His gates with thanksgiving
And His courts with praise, Give
thanks to Him, bless His name.”
- We should come to worship with
thanksgiving and praise

Vs. 5

- “For the Lord is good”
 - He is good to all of us
- “His lovingkindness is everlasting”
- “And His faithfulness to all generations”
