Our English Bible

- John Wycliffe first translated the Bible into English in 1382. It was translated from the Latin Vulgate.
- William Tyndale translated the Bible into English from Hebrew and Greek texts in 1525.
- Followed by Coverdale's (1535), Matthew's (1537), Taverner's (1539), Great Bible (1539), Geneva Bible (1560), Bishop's Bible (1568), Authorized Version (1611).
