

Acts 2:14 - 3

Three questions:

- John 20:19-23
 - John doesn't use the word apostle to refer to the twelve.
 - Then the LORD God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being. (Gen. 2:7 NAU)
 - Then He said to me, "Prophecy to the breath, prophecy, son of man, and say to the breath, 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe on these slain, that they come to life.'"" (Ezek. 37:9 NAU)

Three questions

- Acts 1:23
 - “nominated” – “to cause to stand”, put forward, appoint
 - Could there be more than two?
- Acts 2:3 – “tongues”
 - Glossa – (1) organ of speech and taste; (2) speech or language

2:14-21 – What is this?

- And everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved; for on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there will be deliverance, as the LORD has said, even among the survivors whom the LORD calls. (Joel 2:32 NIV)

 - What is God's plan of salvation?
