Memorial Day

- Federal Holiday for remembering those who died while serving in our armed forces.
- Originated as Decoration Day following the Civil War.
- Memorial Day is not to be confused with Veterans Day.

Memorial Day

- Next four years 75th anniversary of those who served and died during World War II.
 - December 7, 1941 – Pearl Harbor
 - December 8, 1941 – war on Japan
 - December 11, 1941 – war on Germany and Italy
 - May 8, 1945 – Victory in Europe
 - August 14 / September 2, 1945 – Victory Japan

Memorial Day

- 25 different cities claim to be the birthplace of the Memorial Day celebration.
- 1.5 million people will watch the National Memorial Day Parade.
- 818 will be eaten every second on Memorial Day.
