- Two fish, 5 loaves
 - Mark 6:38 – “Go and see”
- Twelve baskets of broken pieces
- Mark 6:52 – “They had not understood about the loaves”



Peter's Walk



- Only recorded by Matthew
- Not recorded by Mark nor John
- Mark 6:48 “saw disciples straining at the oars”

“Straining at the oars”

– strictly *rub on the touchstone*, a Lydian stone used to test the genuineness of metals; hence *test* or *make proof of* anything; (1) of bodily disease *torment, cause great pain*; passive *be in great pain* (2) passive, of birth pangs *suffer pain, be in anguish* (3) figuratively, of any severe distress *afflict, torment, harass*
