LUKE 10

- Vs. 1-15 – Jesus sends out 72
- "Whoever listens to you listens to me; whoever rejects you rejects me; but whoever rejects me rejects him who sent me." (Lk. 10:16 NIV)
- Vs. 17-19 – disciples return with joy
- Vs. 20 – "Rejoice that your names are written in heaven."
- Vs. 21 – Jesus full of joy
- Vs. 23-24 – blessed who see and hear
