- Through faith in Jesus we become a part of the family of the faithful.

# FAITH

- Defined – belief directed toward a person or thing – confidence, faith, trust, reliance on, commitment.
- *So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ. (Rom. 10:17 ESV)*
- The assurance/confidence of things hoped for.
- The conviction/assurance of things not seen.

# FAITH

- “This is what the ancients were commended for.”
- It is impossible to please God without it.
- To come to Him:
  - We must believe He exist.
  - And, He rewards those who earnestly seek Him.

# FAITH

- *By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible. (Heb. 11:3 NIV)*
- He is the ruler of it all.



# FAITH

- Faith will cause you to do the better thing.
- Commend you as righteous.
- Philippians 3:8-9
- Cause God to speak well of you and what you do.
- Faith will allow you to please God. (vs. 4)
- Faith will cause you to give careful heed to what God has said and give you great care in following His instructions. (vs. 7)



# FAITH

- Faith means you will trust and obey even when you do not know where you are going. (vs. 8)
- Faith will cause you to live your life for the unseen world which is coming instead of the world you can see. (vs. 16)
- Living that way, God is not ashamed to be known as your God. (vs. 16)
