Matthew's account

- Matthew 23:37-38
- Already entered Jerusalem – chapter 21
- Context is between the 7 woes to the Scribes and Pharisees and Jesus telling of the destruction of Jerusalem.

Luke's account

- Luke 13:31-35
 - Jesus headed to Jerusalem
 - In the territory of Herod Antipas – governor of Galilee and Perea
 - “That fox” –
 - Another verse – Luke 19:41-44

The first verse:

"Jerusalem, Jerusalem, who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, the way a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, and you were unwilling." (Matt. 23:37 NAU)

- "*The city*" instead of who – "just as" instead of "the way" – Luke 13:34

- "Behold, your house is being left to you desolate! "For I say to you, from now on you will not see Me until you say, 'BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!'" (Matt. 23:39 NAU)
