THE LAMB HAS COME

- Word of his coming dates back to the beginning of time.
- He would be the seed of woman.
- The seed of Abraham that would bless the whole world.
- The Lion of the tribe of Judah.
- Descendent of David.
- A priest after the order of Melchizedek.
- A prophet like Moses.
- The King of God's eternal kingdom.

THE LAMB HAS COME

- Isaiah 9:6-7 – He would be divine – God
 - He would be born of a virgin.
 - He would be born in Bethlehem – and so it was.
 - Those who knew the scriptures pointed the wisemen to Bethlehem.
 - The angels sang to the shepherds of his birth.
 - The lamb came to the world.
 - John the baptizer said, “There he is, the lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world.”

THE LAMB HAS COME

- The Lamb showed us God.
- To see him was to see God and hear God.
- He came to die for our sins.
- He came as the lamb of sacrifice to take away the sins of all men.
- He died and rose again on the third day.
- The lamb ascended into heaven.
- He is seated at the right hand of God.
- He is now King of all kings – Lord of all lords.

THE LION IS COMING

- He will not come again as a baby.
- He will come as King of kings and Lord of lords.
- Angels will not sing at his coming.
- They will shout with a great noise.
- Every eye will see him.
- Men will try to hide in the rocks and beg for the mountains to fall on them to hide them from the Lion of Judah.

THE LION IS COMING

- He will not come to forgive sins.
- He will come to judge.
- He will divide all humans into those who have listened to him and those who have not.
- He will destroy eternally those who have not listened.
- He will say “Well done” to those who have listened.
- The lamb has come, the Lion is coming.
