Use Your Gift

- *“If prophecy, according to the proportion of his faith” (6b) – public and private proclamation.*
- *“If service, in his serving” (7a) – helping others.*
- *“Or he who teaches, in his teaching” (7b) - classroom and one-on-one Bible instruction.*

- *“Or he who exhorts, in his exhortation” (8a) – en-courage-ment with a push.*
- *“He who gives, with liberality” (8b) – the giving of yourself: time, talent, and treasure.*
- *“He who leads, with diligence” (8c) – not lazy!*
- *“He who shows mercy, with cheerfulness” (8d) – genuine forgiveness.*
