

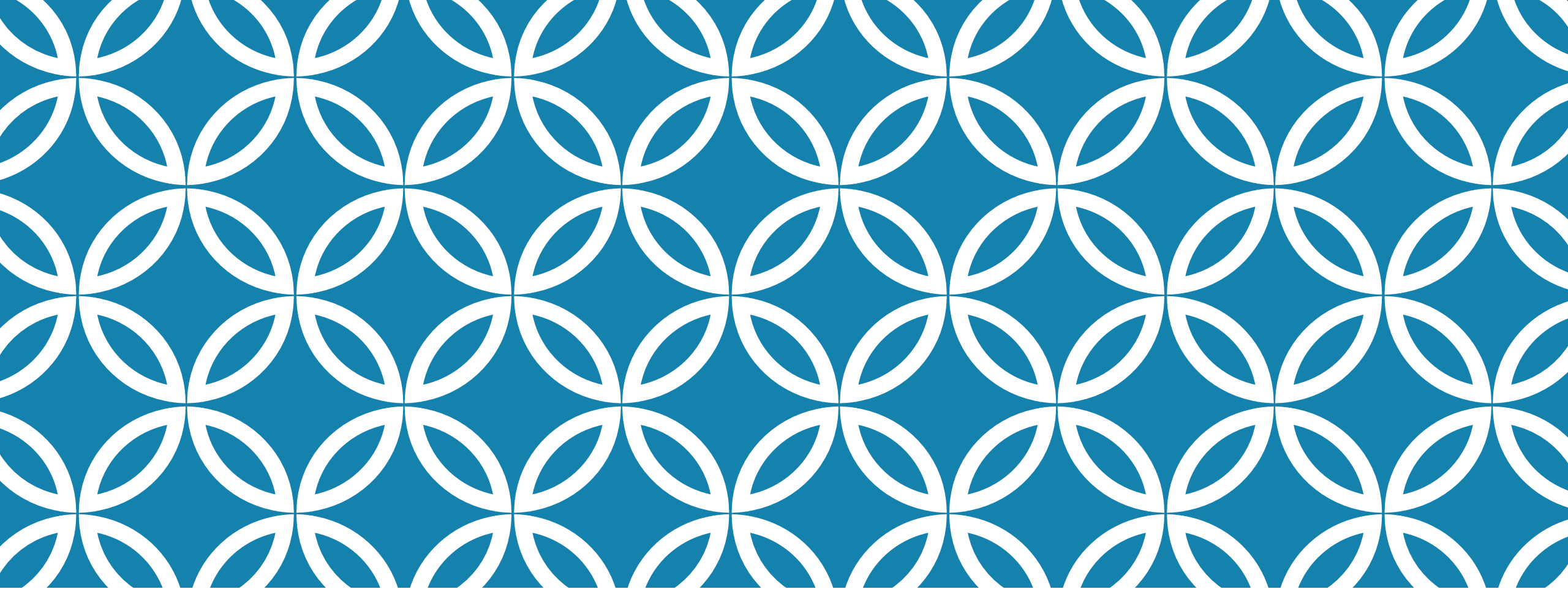

- David's wives and sons in Hebron:
  - Michal – Saul's daughter
  - Ahinoam of Jezreel – Amnon
  - Abigail – Kileab (called Daniel in 1 Chron. 3:1)
  - Maakah – Absalom
  - Haggith – Adonijah (1 Kings 1 & 2)
  - Abital – Shephatiah
  - Eglah – Ithream

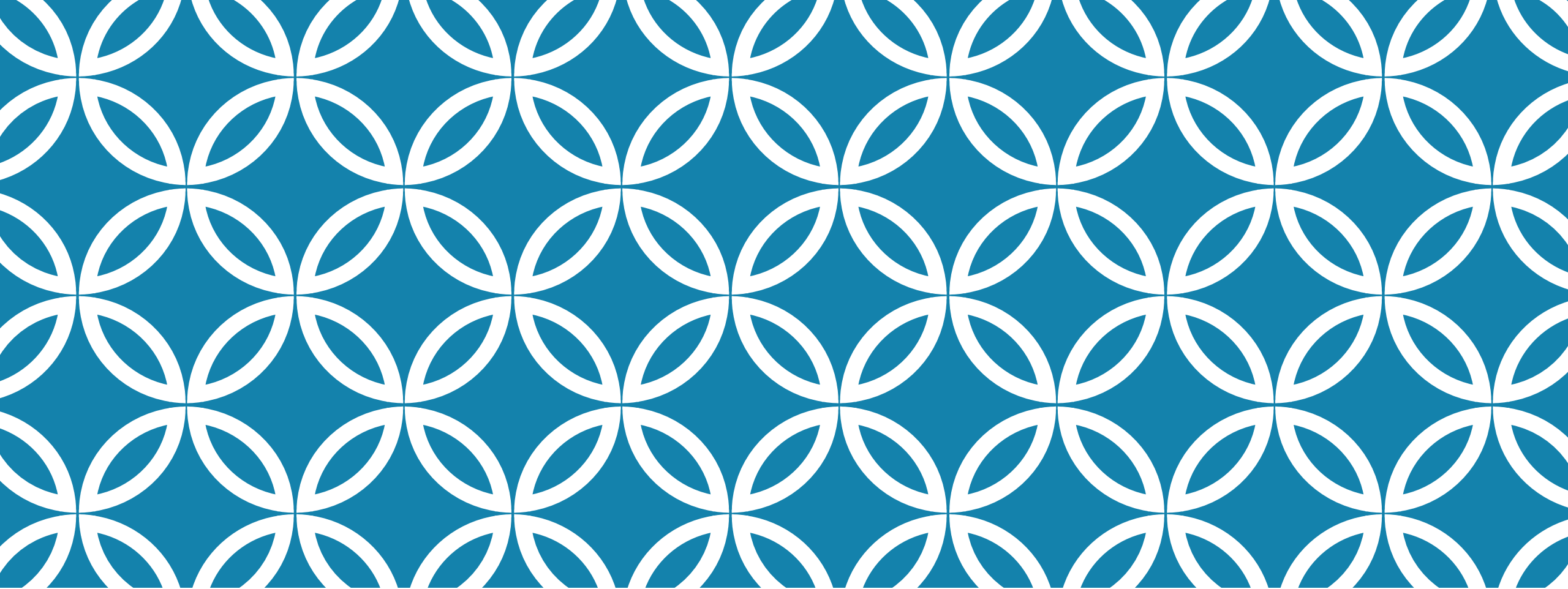


## 2SAMUEL 3-4

- David's wives and sons in Hebron:

## 2SAMUEL 3-4

- 3:6-11 – Falling out between Abner and Ish-Bosheth
- 3:12-21 – Abner turns to David
  - 13:13-13-16) – David's one condition
    - Michal – 1 Sam. 14:49; 18:20-29; 19:11-17; 25:44; 2Sam. 6:16-23
    - Deut. 24:1-4
- 3:22-39 – Abner killed by Joab
- 4:1-12 – Ish-Bosheth killed



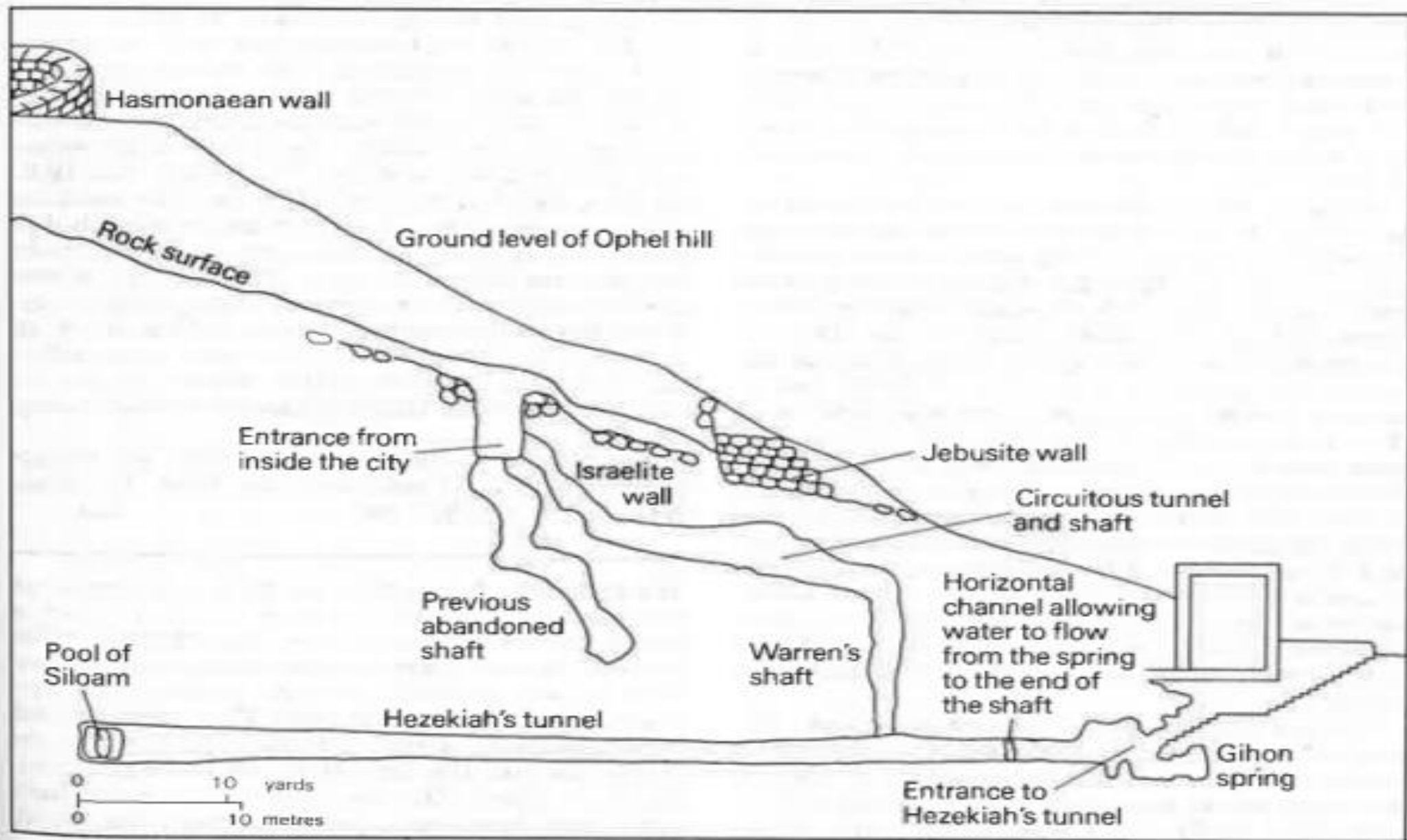

## CHAPTERS 5-7

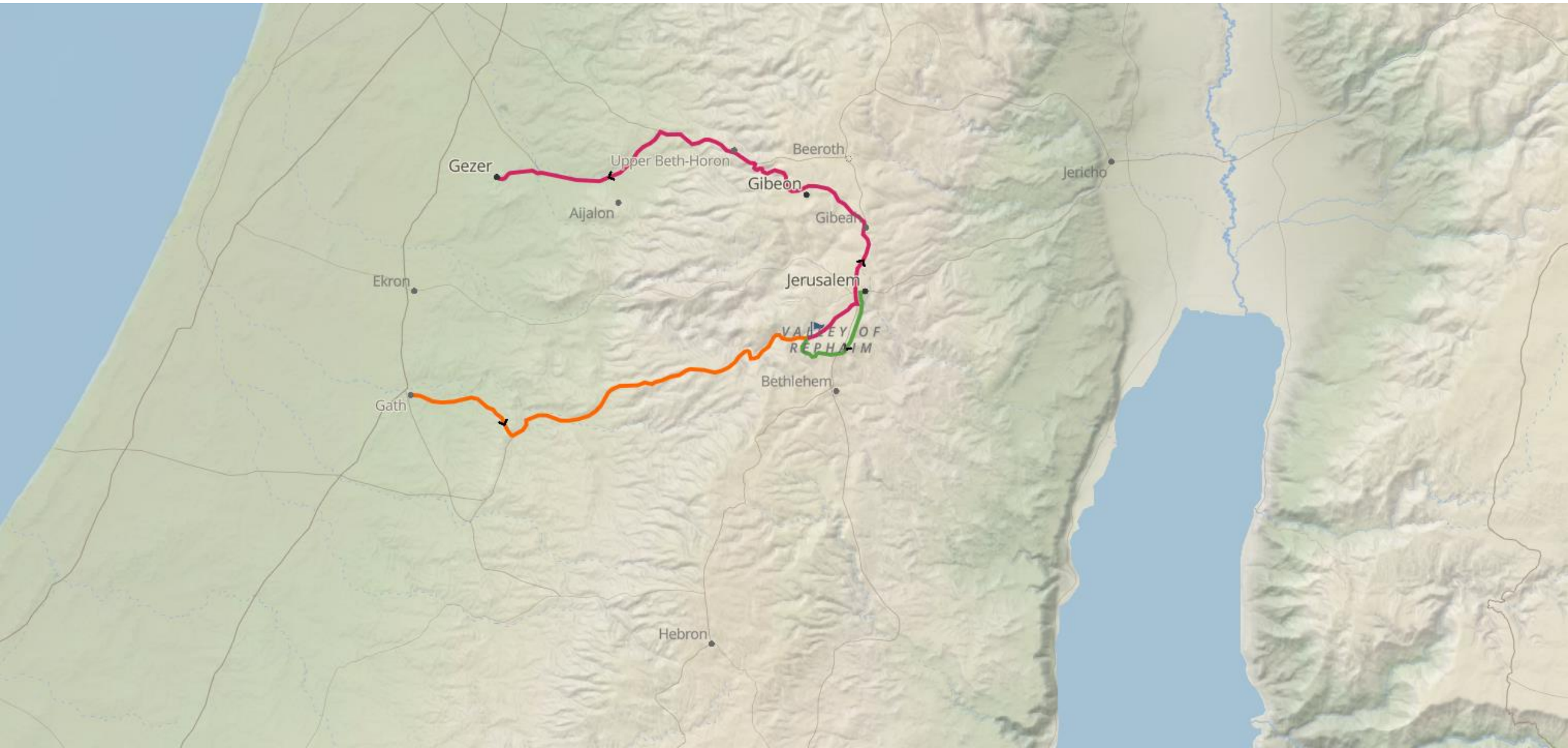
- 5:1-5 – David anointed king over Israel and Judah
  - Anointed three times – 1 Sam. 16:13; 2 Sam. 2:4; 5:3
- 5:6-10 - David takes Jerusalem (Jebus, Salem) (1 Chron 11:4-9)
  - Jebusites – Joshua 15:63;
- 5:11-12 – Hiram builds David's palace
- 5:13-16 – David takes more wives
  - Deut. 17:14-20
- 5:17-25 – David defeats Philistines (1 Chron 14:8-17, vs. 12)

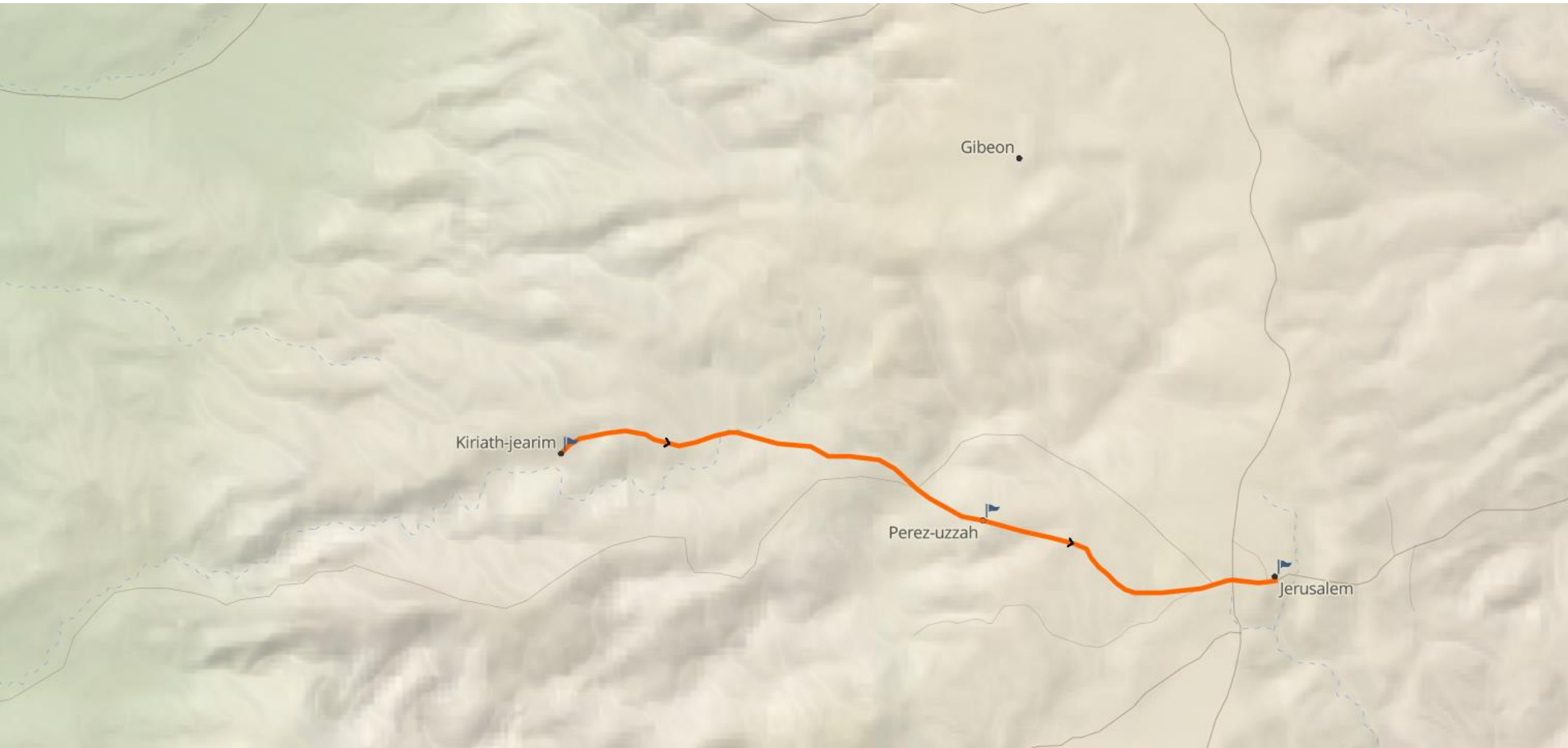

  - 6:17 – to the tent David had pitched for it (1 Chron. 16:1)
- 6:20-23 – David and Michal

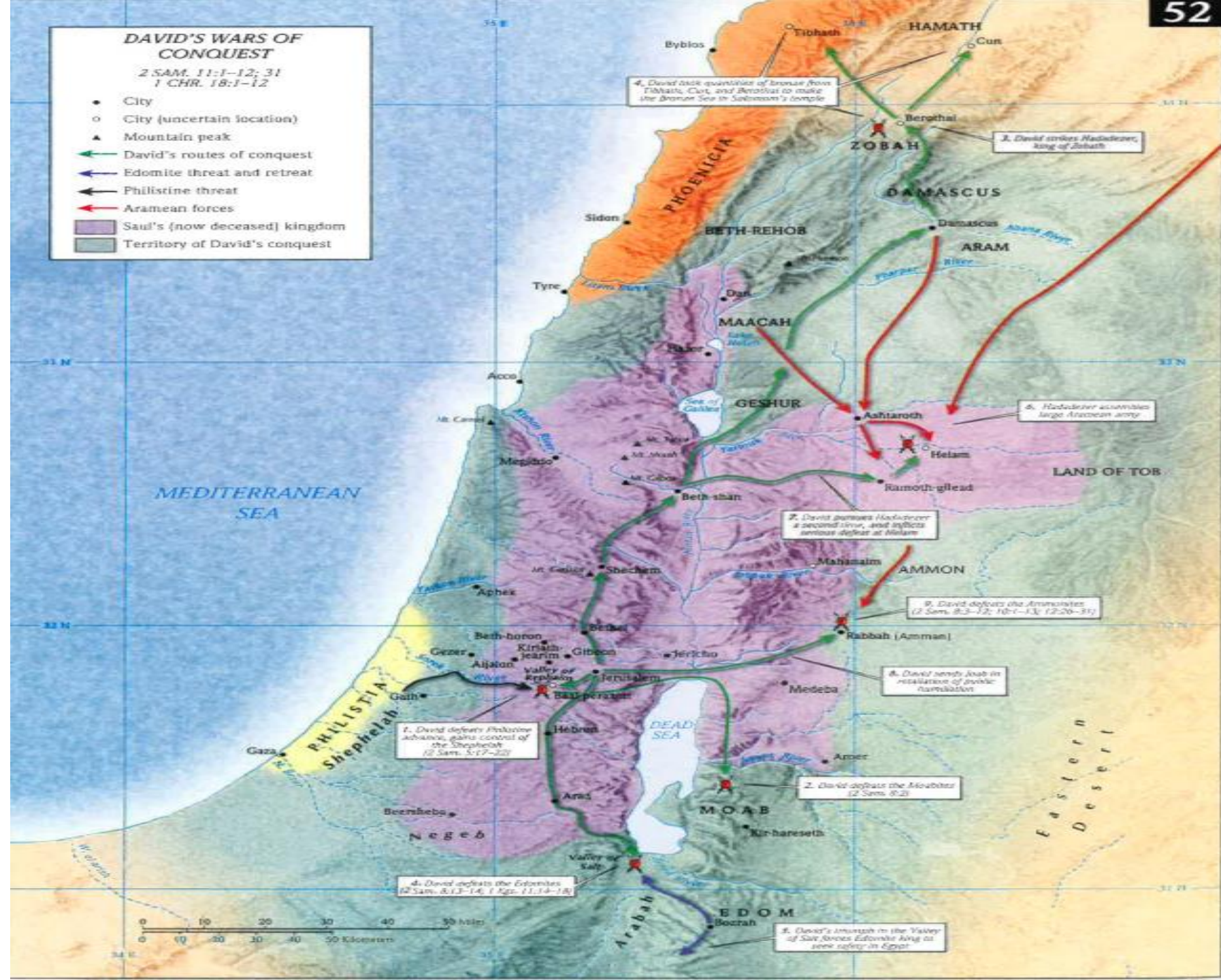
## 2SAMUEL 8-10

- 7:9-11 – God’s promise
  - 8:6, 14
- 1 Chron. 22:14 – amount of gold and silver for the temple
- 8:1 – “Metheg Ammah” – “The bridle of one cubit”

### DAVID'S WARS OF CONQUEST

2 SAM. 11:1-12; 31  
1 CHR. 18:1-12

- City
- City (uncertain location)
- ▲ Mountain peak
- David's routes of conquest
- ← Edomite threat and retreat
- ← Philistine threat
- ← Aramean forces
- Saul's (now deceased) kingdom
- Territory of David's conquest



4. David took quantities of bronze from Tibhath, Cun, and Bethath to make the bronze sea in Solomon's temple

3. David strikes Hadadezer, king of Zobah

6. Hadadezer assembles large Aramean army

7. David pursues Hadadezer a second time, and inflicts serious defeat at Helam

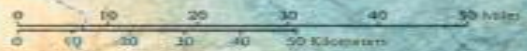
9. David defeats the Ammonites (2 Sam. 8:2-12; 10:1-13; 12:26-31)

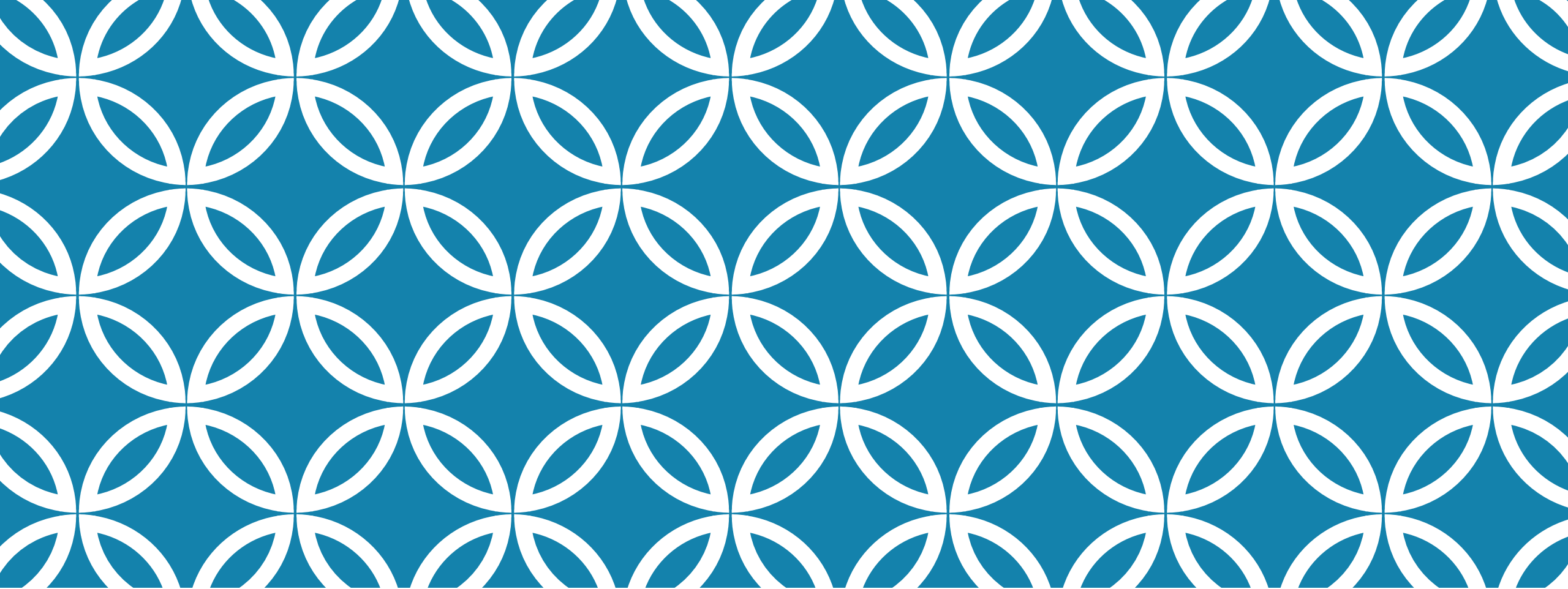
8. David sends Joab in retaliation of Ammonite harassment

2. David defeats the Moabites (2 Sam. 8:2)

4. David defeats the Edomites (2 Sam. 8:13-14; 1 Chr. 18:14-16)

5. David's triumph in the Valley of Salt forces Edomite King to seek safety in Egypt
