Sequence

- Games: Ticket to Ride & Sequence
- Sequence - a particular order in which related events, movements, or things follow each other.
- Driving a car:
 - Start - stop - steer

Michael Landon: "Everyone should be told when they are born that they are going to die."

- How do you miss this?
- An exception:
 - 1Thess. 4:16-17 - dead in Christ first, then those alive
 - 1Cor. 15:51 - changed - mortal to immortal
- But there is more - even after death.

Just as people are destined to die once, and after that to face judgment, (Heb. 9:27 NIV)

- We all stand before Jesus to be judged by him.
- There is a first resurrection and there is a second resurrection.
- There is a first death and there is a second death.
- Rev. 20:4-6, 14; 21:8
- The first resurrection – Rom. 6; 1Jn. 3:14; Jn. 13:35; Rev. 7:13-17
