Holy Spirit and the Bible

- "For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God; for He gives the Spirit without measure. (Jn. 3:34 NAU) [3:31-36]
- "God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth." (Jn. 4:24 NAU)
- "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit and are life. (Jn. 6:63 NAU)
- "He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, 'From his innermost being will flow rivers of living water. But this He spoke of the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive; for the Spirit was not yet *given*, because Jesus was not yet glorified.'" (Jn. 7:38-39 NAU)

Holy Spirit

- John 14:16-17
 - “I will ask the Father”
 - “Helper” Paraclete – “one called alongside to help”, Advocate, Helper, Comforter – strengthening aid.
 - “another” helper – 1John 2:1
 - Spirit of truth
- John 14:26
 - He will teach and remind

Holy Spirit

- John 15:26-27
 - “testify” – (martureo) bear witness, declaration of ascertainable facts based on firsthand knowledge
- John 16:7-15
 - Vs. 7-11 – convict
 - Acts 2
 - Vs. 12-13 – guide you into all truth
 - Vs. 14-15 – He will glorify Christ
