PSALM 19

- Vs. 1-6
 - *“The heavens declare the glory of God, the skies proclaim the work of his hands.”*
 - God – El
 - Sun

PSALM 19

- Vs. 6-9
 - Sun and The Law
 - “Lord” - “Yahveh”
 - Cannot come to fully know the Lord without the word of God.
 - His law – direction, instruction
 - Is perfect
 - Refreshing – restoring, to turn, to bring back
 - The soul – person, being

PSALM 19

- Vs. 6-9
 - His statutes – testimony, commands, declarations
 - Are trustworthy
 - Making wise the simple (open minded)
 - His precepts – directions, orders, things appointed
 - Are right (straight)
 - Giving joy (gladness) to the heart

PSALM 19

- Vs. 6-9
 - His commands – orders, directions
 - Are radiant – giving light to the eyes
 - Fear of the Lord – (revere – to regard with fear mingled with respect and affection: to reverence: to honor in estimation.)
 - Is pure, clean
 - Enduring forever

PSALM 19

- Vs. 6-9
 - His decrees – judgments, ordinances, orders, edicts
 - Are firm – fixed, steady, unshakable
 - Most translations use the word “true”
 - And righteous
- Vs. 10-14
 - More precious than the most valuable and the sweetest.
 - Warned
 - Depth of sin
 - Prayer
