# AHAB

- 1 Kings 16:29-33 – a summary of his life
- 1 Kings 16:34 – an insert (Joshua 6:26, 530 years)
- Chapter 17 – 3 ½ year drought; ravens; widow of Zarephath
- Chapter 18 – Elijah & Obadiah; Mt. Carmel; rain
- Chapter 19 – Ahab tells Jezebel; Elijah flees to Horeb
- Chapter 20 Ben-Hadad, king of Aram attacks Samaria with 32 other kings. He attacks twice. Ahab listens to God's prophet. Spares Ben-Hadad. Vs. 41-43

# AHAB

- 1 Kings 21 – Naboth’s vineyard – vs. 4 – vs. 17-26 – vs. 27-29
- 1 Kings 22 – Jehoshaphat and Ahab – Ramoth Gilead – 400 prophets – Micaiah – vs. 8 – vs. 18 – vs. 37
- *Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise and exalt and glorify the King of heaven, because everything he does is right and all his ways are just. And those who walk in pride he is able to humble. (Dan. 4:37 NIV)*
