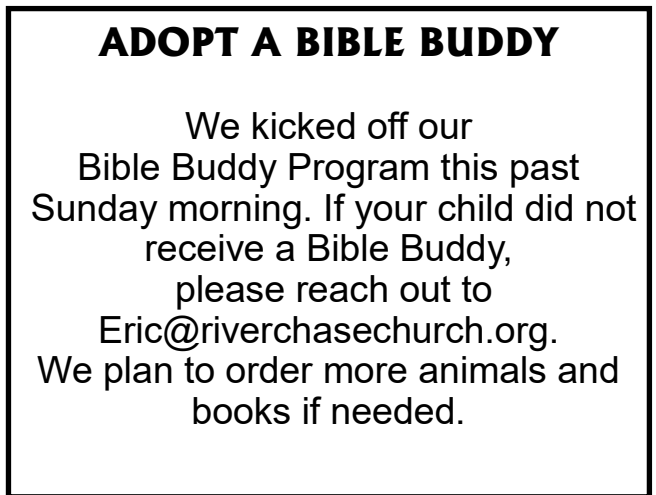

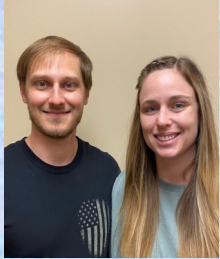

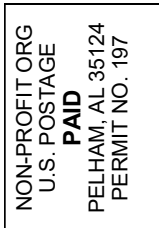


## Bridal Tea
