However, instead of being separated by individual grades and studying different topics, we will instead be in classes consisting of two grades at a time and every class will be studying the same topic, but on a level that is appropriate for them.

Hopefully this will give us a deeper and more enveloping dive into the scriptures as our teens grow closer to God and to one another.

On the first Wednesday of the month we will have teen supper and invite our friends, (Fwednesday) then on second and fourth Wednesdays we will have our adult led small groups we call Canoes, and on the third and fifth Wednesdays we will have Mix it up Wednesdays where we can have flexibility to let teens lead, talk about current events, or address particular needs!
