 - “Justify himself”
 - Lev. 19:17-18, 34

- The parable
 - “A man”
 - A priest and a Levite
 - Samaritan
 - Pity, compassion
 - Dressed wounds, put on his donkey, took to an inn, took care of him, gave money to inn keeper, promise to return and repay
