THE DEATH OF JESUS WAS A CRUSHING BLOW

- Most of the disciples did not watch him suffer on the cross.
 - John and a few women including this mother watched in anguish.
- The twelve were not there when Joseph of Arimathea and Nicodemus took his body down and placed it in the tomb.





CONFUSION AT THE EMPTY TOMB

- According to Mark 16:1, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Solome brought spices, so that they might go and anoint him.
- Luke 24:2–4; ² And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, ³ but when they went in they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. ⁴ While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men stood by them in dazzling apparel.
