Exodus 12:1-7

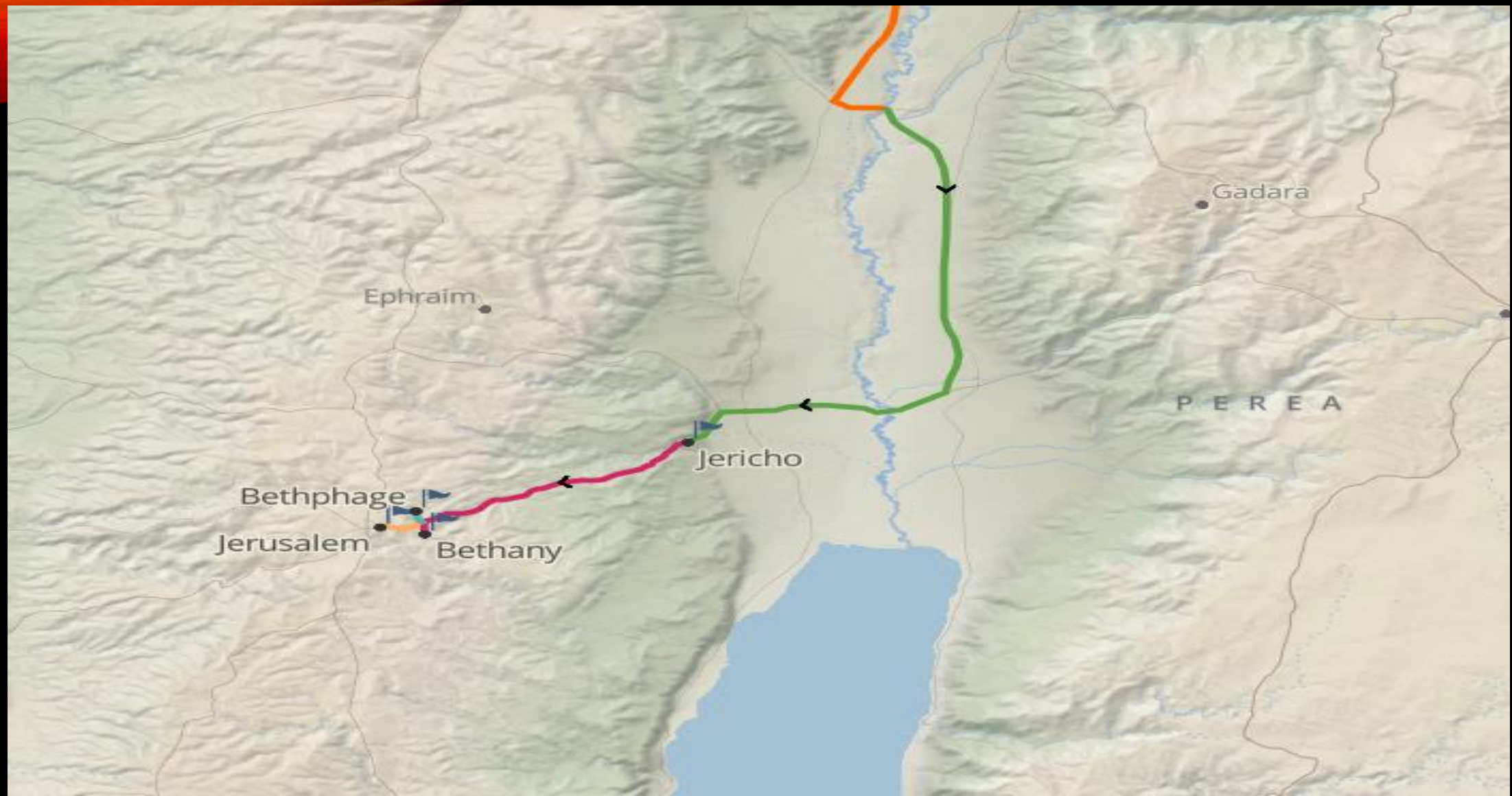
JOURNEY TO JERUSALEM

- Pharisees and divorce
- Jesus blesses children
- Rich young ruler
- Tells of his suffering, death and resurrection for third time
- James and John make request
- Jesus talks of service to be great
- Jericho – Zacchaeus – blind man healed
- Parable of ten talents – headed toward Jerusalem
- Many looking for Jesus at the Passover
- At Bethany – Mary – a plan to kill Lazarus and Jesus –

SIX DAYS BEFORE PASSOVER

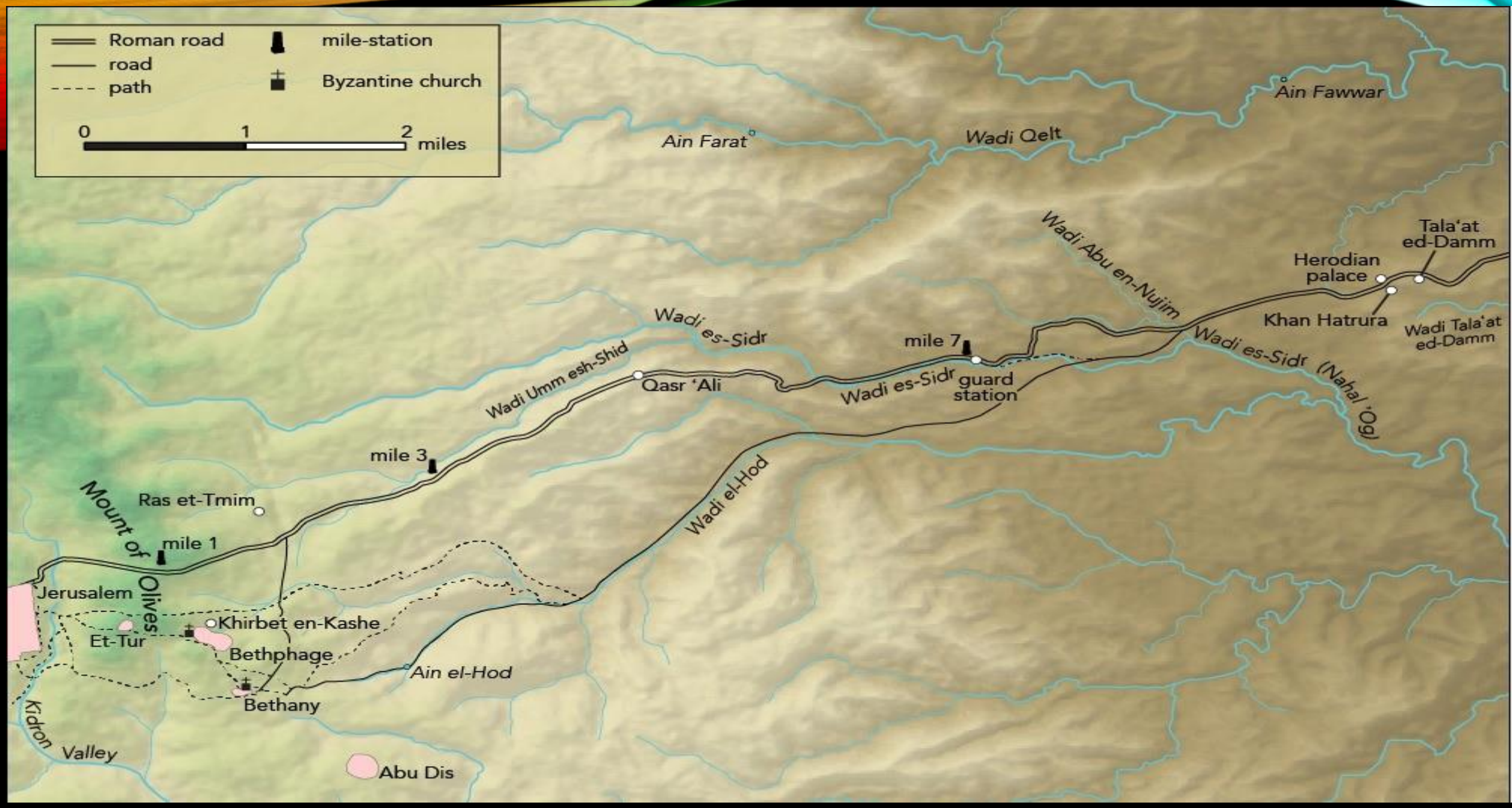


1. 29 ½ days to cycle
2. Month begins on New Moon
3. Months 30 or 29 days
4. Add month every 3 years
5. Full moon on 14th or 15th.

PASSOVER

- Month of Nisan – first month of new year
- 10th day of month select lamb
- Care for lamb until 14th day
- Slaughter lamb at twilight on 14th day, eat meat that night
- Unleavened bread from evening of 14th day till evening of 21st day

SUNDAY

- At Bethany & Bethphage two disciples get donkey
- People shout “Hosanna” “Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord”
- Pharisees demand he rebuke his followers
- Jesus wept over Jerusalem and prophesied destruction
- People make him known to all
- Pharisees – “This is getting us nowhere. The whole world has gone after him.”
- Jesus went to the temple, looked around, back to Bethany

AMONG HIS FINAL WORDS

- “Have you not read what God said from the beginning?”
- “Don’t forbid the children from coming to me”
- “Leave your wealth and come follow me”
- “The greatest among you will be the servant of all”
- Those seeking him and repenting will certainly find him
- Leaving to become a king who will reward his faithful ones
- Many looking for Jesus, but not what they expected
- Wept over Jerusalem – twice – choice
- Unfruitful fig tree
- My house shall be a house of prayer
