- Offer praise – vs. 1-2, 4
- Why – vs 3, 5
- Psalms is full of human emotions
- “Make a joyful noise” – “Shout for joy” all the earth
 - David’s anger when Uzzah was killed
- Vs. 2 – Serve (worship) the Lord with gladness, come into his presence with singing
 - Psalm 15; 24:3-6

Psalm 100

- Vs. 3 – Know that the Lord is God
- “It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.
 - David speaks to God about his enemies (Ps. 55 & 59)
- Vs. 4 – Enter his gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise! Give thanks to him; bless his name. (Is. 2:2-3; Micah 4:1-2)
- For the Lord is good; his steadfast love endures forever, and his faithfulness to all generations.
