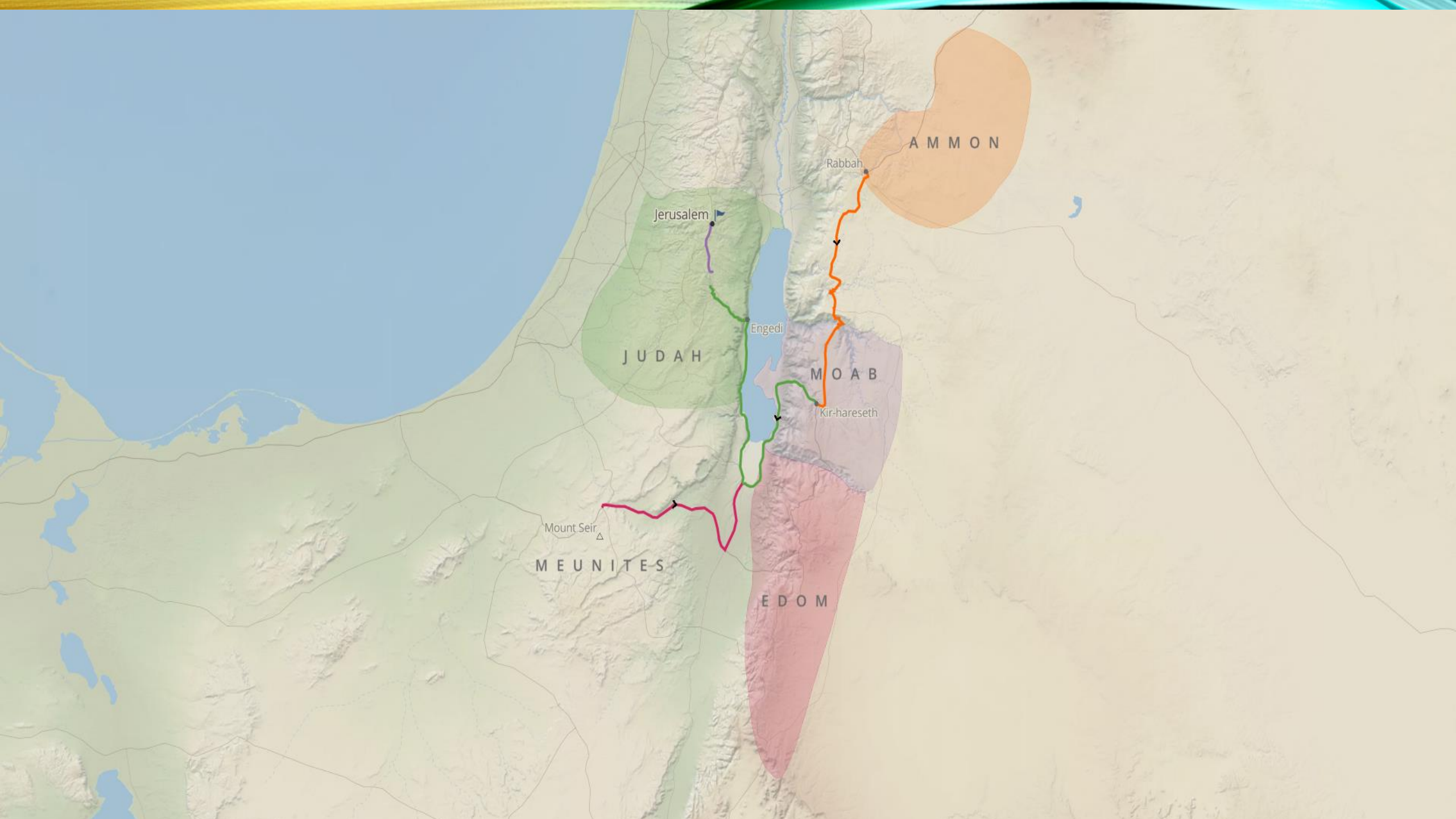

- "I'm watching you."
- Solomon
- Rehoboam – listened at first, then abandoned God's law
- Abijah – defeated Jeroboam because he relied on God
- Asa – good king, relied on the Lord
- Jehoshaphat

# JEHOSHAPHAT

- 2Chron 17:3-5 – God with him, he sought God and obeyed
- 17:7 – sent out his officials to teach the Law to the people
- 17:10 – fear of the Lord fell on the kingdoms around them
- 18:1 – Made a marriage alliance with Ahab for his son Jehoram
- *He walked in the way of Asa his father and did not turn aside from it, doing what was right in the sight of the LORD. (2 Chr. 20:32 ESV)*

# JEHOSHAPHAT

- 3 kingdoms decide to destroy Judah – Ammonites, Moabites and Mount Seir
- Jehoshaphat prays to God
- They go to battle but will not fight
- *“Have faith in the Lord your God and you will be upheld; have faith in his prophets and you will be successful.” 20:20*
- They went to the battle singing praises to God
- 2Chron 20:22-24

• "Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, declares the LORD. For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people. And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more." (Jer. 31:31-34 ESV)

## EYES ON HIM

- *"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. (Jn. 3:16 ESV)*
- *<sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.*
- *<sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,*
- *<sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." (Matt. 28:18-1:1 ESV)*
