# GOSSIP

Leviticus 19:15-18

- Words often used to define: gossip talebearer whisperer tattler
- One who spreads secrets or rumors in order to slander
- One who repeats what ought not to be repeated
- "What is that to me and you?"

- <sup>9</sup> With his mouth the godless man would destroy his neighbor, but by knowledge the righteous are delivered.
- 10 When it goes well with the righteous, the city rejoices, and when the wicked perish there are shouts of gladness.
- <sup>11</sup> By the blessing of the upright a city is exalted, but by the mouth of the wicked it is overthrown. (Prov. 11:9-11 ESV)

## GOSSIP

- <sup>4</sup> An evildoer listens to wicked lips, and a liar gives ear to a mischievous tongue.
- <sup>5</sup> Whoever mocks the poor insults his Maker; he who is glad at calamity will not go unpunished. (Prov. 17:4-5 ESV)
- <sup>9</sup> Whoever covers an offense seeks love, but he who repeats a matter separates close friends.
- <sup>10</sup> A rebuke goes deeper into a man of understanding than a hundred blows into a fool. (Prov. 17:9-10 ESV)

- 15 "You shall do no injustice in court. You shall not be partial to the poor or defer to the great, but in righteousness shall you judge your neighbor.
- 16 You shall not go around as a slanderer among your people, and you shall not stand up against the life of your neighbor: I am the LORD.
- 17 "You shall not hate your brother in your heart, but you shall reason frankly with your neighbor, lest you incur sin because of him.
- 18 You shall not take vengeance or bear a grudge against the sons of your own people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself: I am the LORD. (Lev. 19:15-18 ESV)

- 14 For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."
- 15 But if you bite and devour one another, watch out that you are not consumed by one another. (Gal. 5:14-15 ESV)

- <sup>28</sup> And since they did not see fit to acknowledge God, God gave them up to a debased mind to do what ought not to be done.
- <sup>29</sup> They were filled with all manner of unrighteousness, evil, covetousness, malice. They are full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, maliciousness. They are gossips,
- <sup>30</sup> slanderers, haters of God, insolent, haughty, boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents,
- 31 foolish, faithless, heartless, ruthless.
- <sup>32</sup> Though they know God's righteous decree that those who practice such things deserve to die, they not only do them but give approval to those who practice them. (Rom. 1:28-32 ESV)
