

CHAPTERS 38-40

Recap

- Conversation between God & Satan about Job (chapter 1)
- God grants Satan permission to take away Job's wealth & children
- God grants Satan permission to afflict Job by taking away his health (chapter 2)
- Three of Job's friends come to comfort him and sit with him in silence for 7 days
- Job speaks about his misery and curses the day he was born; however, he makes no accusations against God (chapter 3)
- Back and forth exchange between Job and his 4 friends (chapters 4-37)

Chapters 38-40 God Speaks

Job 38:1-3 (ESV)

Then the LORD answered Job out of the whirlwind and said: "Who is this that darkens counsel by words without knowledge? Dress for action like a man; I will question you, and you make it known to me.

➤ What do you think Job felt when he heard God speak to him?

Absolutely stunned

Great relief

Hey David...if it's ok with you, let's meet in the church parking lot tomorrow at 2:00. thanks

Hey Mary! I hope your day is going well! If it's ok with you, let's meet in the church parking lot tomorrow at 2:00. So excited to see you!

- ➤ How Would You Characterize God's Initial Response to Job? What is His Mood/Demeanor ? (Vs. 1-3)
 - Sarcasm?
 - In essence, God says "Job, I really could have used your help when I created everything."

- ➤ God is also about to use lots of examples & repetition to help us understand the futility of challenging and debating God
 - Job heard God's tone of voice. The repetition must have been overwhelming to Job, but also helps our understanding of God's point.

God's Questioning of Job

- God's wisdom and power as displayed in the created universe (38:4-38)
- God's creation of and care for the animal kingdom (38:39-39:30)
- God's restraint of the forces of evil in the world (40:11-13)

Mysteries of Earth & Nature

- Job 38:4-11
 - Design & creation, ocean boundaries
 - 4 "Where were you when I laid the foundation of the earth?

Tell me, if you have understanding.

- 5 Who determined its measurements–surely you know!
- Or who stretched the line upon it?
- 6 On what were its bases sunk, or who laid its cornerstone,
- 7 when the morning stars sang together and all the sons of God shouted for joy?

Mysteries of Earth & Nature, con't.

- Job 38:16-18
 - Ocean depths, death, expanse of earth
 - 16 "Have you entered into the springs of the sea, or walked in the recesses of the deep?
 - 17 Have the gates of death been revealed to you, or have you seen the gates of deep darkness?
 - 18 Have you comprehended the expanse of the earth? Declare, if you know all this.

Mysteries of Earth & Nature, con't.

- Job 38:19-21, 24
 - Light
 - 19 "Where is the way to the dwelling of light, and where is the place of darkness,
 - 20 that you may take it to its territory and that you may discern the paths to its home?
 - 21 You know, for you were born then, and the number of your days is great!

Job 40:1-5

Then the LORD said to Job, 2 "Do you still want to argue with the Almighty? You are God's critic, but do you have the answers?"

3 Then Job replied to the LORD,
4 "I am nothing—how could I ever find the answers?
I will cover my mouth with my hand.
5 I have said too much already.
I have nothing more to say."

Job 40:6-14

- God again challenges Job with things he cannot answer
 - "Are you condemning me so that you will be in the right?"
 - "Can you thunder with a voice like God?"
 - "Are you majestic and clothed with glory and splendor?"
 - "Are you able to deal with wicked people and put them in their place?"

- ➤ How does God answer Job's question of "why is all of this happening to me?"
 - God doesn't answer the question directly

➤ God's Answer:

- I'm not going to explain it to you, because there is no way for you to understand.
- You must have faith in Me even during adversity.
- You must trust Me.

- ➤ God's overwhelming response helps Job understand:
 - ▶ Job, you need to remember who I am, and who you are ▶ Let God be God
 - ➤ Job, you don't know what you don't know
 - ➤ God knows and sees what we cannot

Some Observations for Us

➤ What God does is just and right by definition

Fear drives us to question circumstances (& God)

The ultimate question is "do you trust Him?"
