# THE WILL OF GOD

- Will?
- 6,209 times in English Standard Version.
- Webster's Dictionary gives 8 different usages as a verb.
- Webster gives 6 different usages as a noun.
  - A will – a legal document describing a persons wishes regarding disposal of property or estate.
  - A desire or wish.
  - Something desired – especially of a choice or determination of one having authority or power – a request or command.

# THE WILL OF GOD

- *Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. (Matt. 6:10 ESV)*
- *And going a little farther he fell on his face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will." (Matt. 26:39 ESV)*
- *If anyone's will is to do God's will, he will know whether the teaching is from God or whether I am speaking on my own authority. (Jn. 7:17 ESV)*

# THE WILL OF GOD

- *Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. (Rom. 12:2 ESV)*
- *give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. (1 Thess. 5:18 ESV)*
- *For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God you may receive what is promised. (Heb. 10:36 ESV)*

# THE WILL OF GOD

- *Since therefore Christ suffered in the flesh, arm yourselves with the same way of thinking, for whoever has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin, <sup>2</sup> so as to live for the rest of the time in the flesh no longer for human passions but for the will of God. (1 Pet. 4:1-2 ESV)*
